SUMMARY OF EVENTS

INTRODUCTION

Kansas hosted its 2nd annual Mobility Week the week of November 6 to 12, 2022, with tremendous growth. The Mobility Week initiative was spearheaded by the six Mobility Managers and was modeled after the Florida Mobility Week. Event 45. The City of Derby – Derby Dash provided free rides to and from voter sites on Election Day, November 8, 2022.




