SUMMARY OF EVENTS

INTRODUCTION

Kansas hosted its 3rd annual Mobility Week the week of November 5 to 11, 2023. The Mobility Week initiative was spearheaded by the six Mobility Managers and was modeled after the Florida Mobility Week. It was a celebration of activities intended to promote multiple transportation options and encourage safe travel behavior.

The Mobility Managers successfully partnered with 34 agencies to organize or participate in 57 events in 38 counties, as well as two statewide events. A summary of the events is provided in the following sections.
