# SUMMARY OF EVENTS

## INTRODUCTION

Kansas hosted its 5th annual Mobility Week the week of November 2 to 8, 2025. The Mobility Week initiative was spearheaded by the Kansas Mobility Managers and was modeled after the Florida Mobility Week. It was a celebration of activities intended to promote multiple transportation options and encourage safe travel behavior.

The Mobility Managers successfully partnered with 40 agencies to organize or participate in 62 events in 40 counties, as well as three statewide events. A summary of the events is provided in the following sections.

Event 1. Kansas Photo Challenge for all residents and visitors riding public transportation during Mobility Week. Posting a "selfie" on social media with the hashtag #kansasrides2025.

Event 65. Wabaunsee County Public Transportation sponsored a booth at the Wellness Without Walls event at the high school in Alma.


